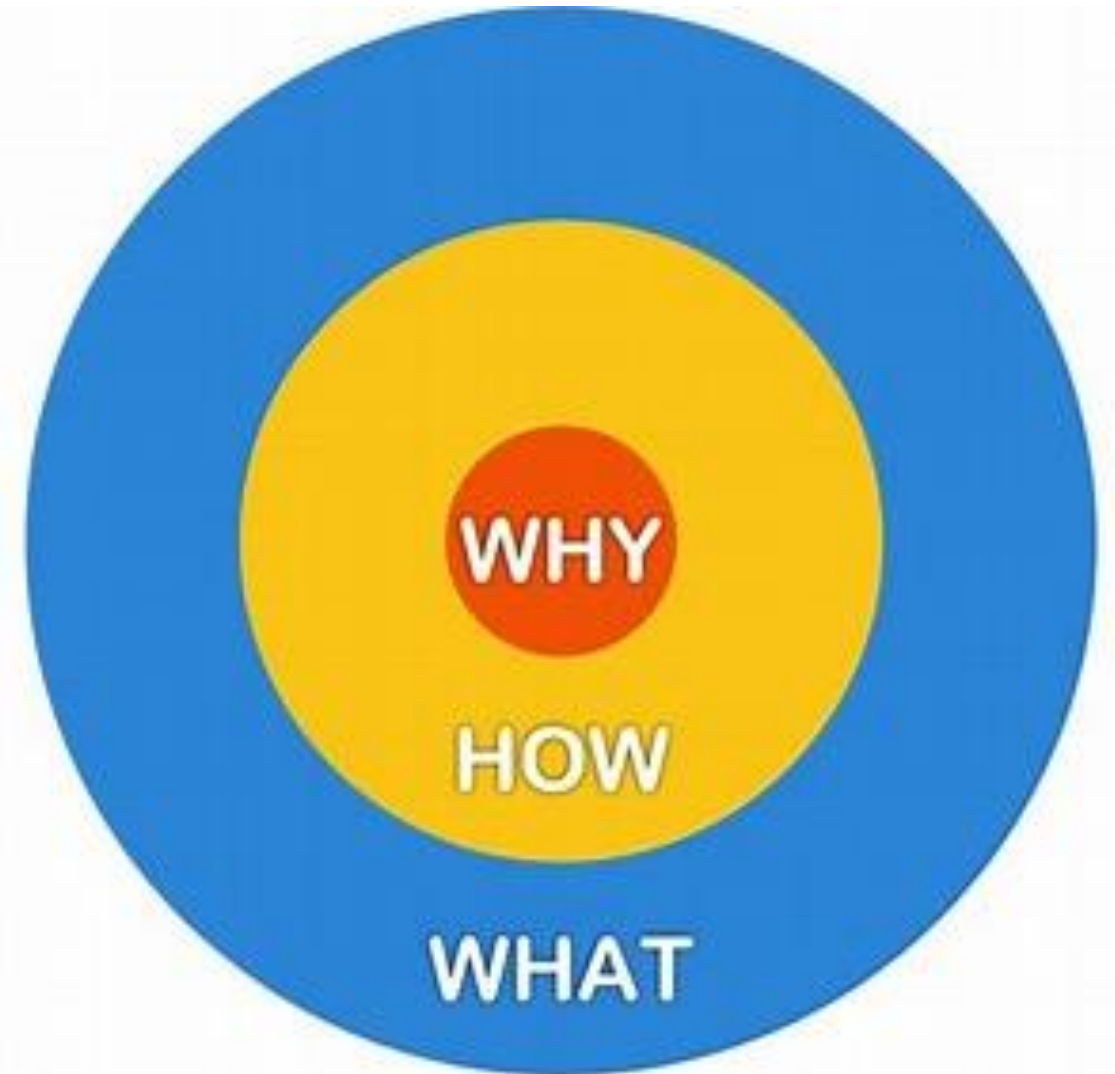

Are charter schools required to have a School Site Council or a Single Plan for Student Achievement?

Charter Schools Division¹

- Yes, pursuant to *EC* Section 47634.4 (Chapter 6, Article 2 of the Charter School Act), if a charter school participates in a program, or receives funding for a program requiring the development of a Single Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) and/or the development of a School Site Council, the charter must comply with those programmatic requirements.
- A school that operates a categorical program funded through the consolidated application (ConApp) shall establish a schoolsite council (SSC) if such program requires a School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA) (*California Education Code [EC] Section 65000[b]*).



Purpose



What is a School Site Council (SSC)?

A **School Site Council (SSC)** is a group of teachers, parents, administrators, and interested community members who work together to develop and monitor a school's improvement plan. It is a legally required decision-making body for any school receiving federal funds.

The California Legislature believes that the individuals who are most affected by the operation of the school should have a major role in the decisions regarding how a school functions. Education should be a joint effort of parents, teachers, administrators, and other school staff. The actions of the School Site Council are the first step in a formal process for developing improvement strategies and for allocating resources to support these efforts.

The SSC decides upon the focus of the school's academic instructional programs and all related categorical resource expenditures for a school.

- [Title I - Parts A and D](#)
A federal program to ensure that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and state academic assessments.
- [Title II, Part A - Supporting Effective Instruction](#)
A federal program that increases student academic achievement through strategies such as improving teacher and principal quality and increasing the number of highly qualified teachers in the classroom and highly qualified principals and assistant principals in schools.
- [Title III - Language Instruction for English Learners \(EL\) and Language Instruction for Immigrant Students](#)
A federal program to provide supplementary programs and services to assist EL and immigrant students in achieving grade-level and graduation standards, as well as assisting EL students with acquiring English.
- [Title IV, Part A, Student Support and Academic Enrichment](#)
A federal program to increase capacity to provide all students with access to a well-rounded education, improve conditions for student learning, and improve use of technology to improve the academic achievement and digital literacy of all students.

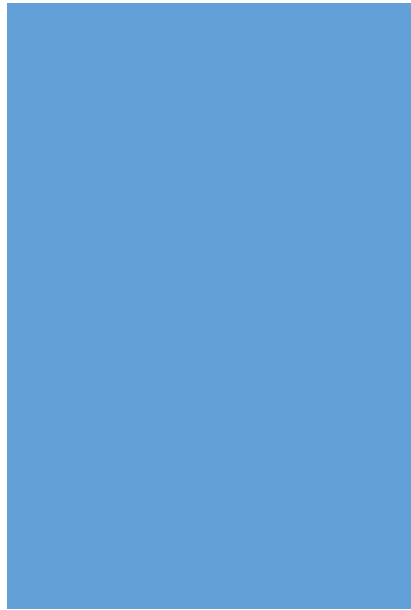
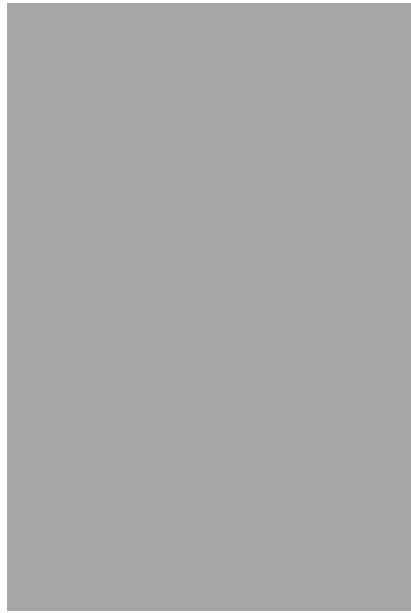
